



Course: Writing for Publication

This course will explore the different routes to publication and examine the pros and cons of these different types of publications.

This course will present the pros and cons of different types of publication including:

- Academic journals (open access and paywalled),
- Chapters and books,
- Self-publishing,
- Audiobooks,
- Blogs,
- Podcasts,
- Vlogs,
- Graphic novels, zines, etc.

The course will also offer tips and tricks for publishing in each of these formats.

By the end of the course participants will:

- Have a technique for auditing their current written assets,
- Have the ability to assess the scope for converting these assets into publications,
- Be able to prioritise their publications to align with career goals.

This course is relevant for researchers from the third sector, public services (e.g. health, criminal justice, social care, education, local or national government), and those who work in independent research organisations or academia.

It is an intermediate level course and attendees will need to bring writing materials (pen and paper or digital device, or both, as preferred). It will be most helpful if attendees have access to their own body of written work on a laptop or tablet, including notes and drafts.
